TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that **MONMOUTHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL** intends to make an Order under S14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The order is being made due to works being executed on the rights of way.

The effect of the Order will be to temporarily close public footpath 142 and restricted byways 183, 182a and 182 Shirenewton as will be indicated on the order plan.

The Order will come into force on the **1st October 2025** and will remain in force for up to six months or until the works are completed, whichever is earlier.

By virtue of Section 16(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 a person who contravenes a restriction or prohibition imposed under Section 14 of the Act shall be guilty of an offence.
