Forthcoming engineering work between Chepstow and Gloucester.

The work will take place from **Monday 12 continuously through to Friday 16 May**.

The projects are essential for maintaining a safe and reliable railway.

- At Newnham-on-Severn, we will be working in the railway tunnel to replace the drainage system and clean the stonework.
- At Naas, near Lydney, we will be replacing track that has reached the end of its working life. Naas level crossing will be temporarily closed during the work and a diversion will be in place.
- Preparation will take place to install new equipment at Broken Cross level crossing near Minsterworth. The main work there will take place later this year.
- Maintenance tasks will also be completed in several areas along the line, including cutting back overgrown vegetation.

So our teams can work safely and efficiently, the railway will be temporarily closed between Gloucester and Chepstow, and buses will replace trains. More information about the replacement service can be found on [Engineering works: Chepstow Gloucester | National Rail](#)
